A Note From The Pastor

Tell Me Your Story

There is a story living inside each of you – one only you can tell.

Maybe it's a memory of a prayer whispered in a hospital hallway, answered in a way you still can't fully explain. Maybe it's a season that stretched and shaped you – one that felt heavy at the time, but through it you came out closer to God than before. Maybe it's a small, ordinary Tuesday when you suddenly felt His nearness so clearly it took your breath away.

I want to hear it!

Not because I need to know every detail of your life to serve as your pastor, but because I believe every one of these stories is holy ground. The God who met you there – in the hallway, through that shaping season, on that ordinary Tuesday – is the same God who is sitting with you right now, in whatever you're carrying today. And I would count it a joy to be invited into that sacred space with you, even for an hour, and to discover together the God who is already present among us – quietly at work in the middle of your story.

So, this is my simple request: let me come and sit with you. Not in an office, not across a desk – wherever feels like home to your heart. Your kitchen table. A porch swing. A coffee shop booth. It doesn't matter where. What matters is that I get to look you in the eyes, ask about your life, and listen.

You'll find a sign-up calendar in the church office and on the bulletin board. Choose whatever date and time feels right, and write your name there. And please, don't worry if you think your story is "too ordinary" – those are often my favorite ones to hear. That's all it takes.

I don't yet know your story. But I already believe it's beautiful – because the One who has been writing it all along still is. Through your story, may we discover together the joy of the God who is already among us.
